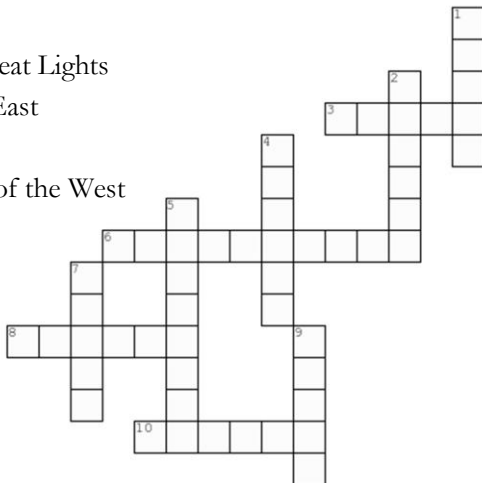
Please excuse the odd formatting and any typographical errors as I make my way through this arduous undertaking so deftly managed for years by RWB Doug! Suggestions welcomed!
